Children having meals has risen from 60 per day to 140 per day. I regularly eat a hot meal and am delighted with the quality. Whilst eating the meals I also chat to the children and they are really pleased with the meals too. We are still working towards making the experience in the hall a really positive one and have invited feedback from staff and pupils and would welcome your views too. For instance, we are considering whether we just let all of our children who order a meal make a choice on the day. TOY GUNS ON OUR SCHOOL SITE

Please ensure that your child does not bring a toy gun with him/her when they come to school. In the last few days we have had children playing with toy guns which, as I am sure you will agree, are totally unacceptable and inappropriate.

CAR PARKING

Please note that the pedestrian access to the car park has been closed due to safety reasons and therefore the only access is across the car park. As such, please can you be very careful if dropping your child off in that area. Mr MacKinnon, our new site manager, is putting together an accessibility plan which includes marked pedestrian areas and disability parking. However, until this is in place please drive responsibly.

Can I also take this opportunity to remind you that we are lucky to have a car park which parents can use for dropping off and picking up. There have been some instances where people have parked inconsiderately or even dangerously in the car park or around school. Following discussions with the governors we have talked about closing the car park if people's first consideration is not safety. Please drive and park sensibly around school—it could be your child who is hurt as a consequence of poor parking.

SWIMMING AT THE LEISURE CENTRE


Just to inform you that our Year 6 children will have swimming lessons up until Christmas, our Year 5 children until Easter and then our Year 4 children in the summer term.
