

In Maths, we are focusing on fluency with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division (In Y1 this is done very practically). We expect children to draw their ideas to help calculation and accuracy. In English, we are learning to develop our writing stamina to produce longer pieces of writing that make sense. There is a greater emphasis on accurate spelling of common exception words that do not follow phonetic rules. Phonics work is continuing to develop reading and writing using alternate long vowel phonemes.
