<b><u>Spelling</u></b> 1. Spelling Rules: These words are homophones or near homophones. They have the same pronunciation but different spellings and/or meanings.	<b><u>Spelling</u></b> 2. Spelling Rules: The prefix 'in-' can mean both 'not' and 'in'/'into.' In these spellings the prefix 'in-' means 'not.'	<b><u>Spelling</u></b> 3. Spelling Rules: Before a root word starting with l, the 'in-' prefix becomes 'il-'. Before a root word starting with r the prefix 'in-' becomes 'ir-'	<b><u>Spelling</u></b> 4.
