

<p>Numberblocks BBC iPlayer Series 2: Fluffies The focus is on one to one correspondence, counting and part-part-whole relationship for number bonds for 7</p> <p>Day 1 - Enjoy watching Numberblocks series 2: Fluffies</p> <p>Day 2 - Watch the same episode again. Ask the children what they noticed. Who was not ticklish? Discuss what they noticed about the number of fluffies that each Numberblock had attached to them. For example, "Two has 2 fluffies because he is made from 2 blocks".</p> <p>Day 3 – use objects found in your home to count out the correct number of objects to match each Numberblock 1-10. What is your strategy? Do you point/move and say, subitise or count on?</p>  <p>Day 4 - Draw the Numberblocks one to ten. Put on the correct number of fluffies for each Numberblock. You</p>	<p>Phonics- Set 1 and set 2 sounds These are on daily. Please remember to practise writing each sound. Reading- RWI books</p> <p>Listen to the online story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=f4kdZTnizG4</p> <p>You could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify any vocabulary that you are unsure of and discuss with a grown up.
