Practise Common exception words.</p> <p>Read/listen to chapters 12 -14 of Charlie and the Chocolate factory</p> <p>You could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify any vocabulary that you are unsure of and look in a dictionary to find the meaning. • How do the crowd react when the factory gates start to open? • Why is the word 'shocking' used to describe Veruca Salt? • At the start of chapter 14, the author uses many short sentences, each on a new line, to describe Willy Wonka. What effect does this have? • Willy Wonka is very expressive with his language. Collect examples of words and phrases that might be described as Wonka-isms. Arrange them around a character sketch of Mr. Wonka. • What do think is inside The Chocolate Room? Make a detailed drawing of your ideas and label each item. Write what you would most like to do in The Chocolate Room and why. <p>SRP: Pick a book on SRP to read and discuss what your child enjoyed about the book. Don't forget to take the quiz!</p>	<p>Ancient Greek Religion</p> <p>The Ancient Greeks were a religious lot. They believed that their gods and goddesses controlled everything in the world and that they must be revered and appeased.</p> <p>Read the Greek God fact file and record facts about some of the main Ancient Greek gods and goddesses. Try to remember what each god represents to the people and what their special weapons or objects are.</p> <p>Choose one God/Goddess and record the information you have learnt.</p>	<p>This week we will be exploring all around the world! <u>Here, there and everywhere!</u></p> <p>Every day you could choose a new country. Take a virtual visit. What animals live in that country?</p> <p>What is special about the people and that place? What do the people like to eat there? Have you tried any of those foods?</p> <p>Can you identify the location country on a map or globe? What is the climate like? Can you identify the flag? What other interesting facts did you learn?</p> <p><u>Paper Plane Challenge</u></p> <p>Take a piece of paper and create the best paper aeroplane that you can.
