treatments and hospitalisation. The memory of the wish may be of their child laughing along with their sporting hero, or being in awe of meeting members of teams they support. In years to come, the family can look back and remember that special time.

International Projects

We are currently working in Burkina Faso and Malawi helping improve the lives of the children there. Whether that be through us providing sports equipment, clothing, educational resources or funds to pay for teaching or anything that is felt will improve the lives and chances of the children there.

Peer Mentoring

We utilise current and former professional athletes as positive role models to help and inspire children through our sports and mentoring programmes.

The programmes are designed to guide children on their journey from formative years to adulthood, empowering them to become role models for the next generation.

We support children dealing multiple issues including: low income families, low self-esteem behaviour, children in care, single parent families and reducing reoffending.
