<p>White Rose Maths – Year 6, Summer term, Week 7</p> <p>This week, there is a continued focus on angles, then the learning moves onto problem solving.</p> <p>Look at the daily lessons.</p> <p>Keep practising your times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.</p>	<p>The Man Who Walked Between The Towers</p> <p>Click on the link above to hear the story of Phillippe Petit, the man who walked on a tightrope between the Twin Towers in New York City. Pause the story where he puts his foot on the wire (don't cheat and go any further!). Create a word bank to describe his thoughts, feelings, what he can see, hear, smell, feel, etc.</p> <p>When you have done this, write from his point of view (1st person) about what is going through his mind. You could do this as thought bubbles, or as a paragraph.</p>	<p>Science – Inheritance</p> <p>Watch the PowerPoint and read each slide carefully. Make a vocabulary sheet for yourself with the key words and their meaning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• DNA;• Cells;• Chromosomes;• Genes;• Inheritance;• Offspring <p>And any others that you may feel as though you want to remember.</p> <p>Complete the task sheet – find a photo of your parents and yourself.
