Follow this link if you need some help. <a href="#">Treasure map help</a></li> <li>• Next, write your message. Remember to write the name of the person you are sending it to and who it is from.</li> <li>• Then edit your message. Check for capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Are they in the right places?</li> <li>• Finally, rewrite your message in your very best handwriting and put it in a bottle.</li> </ul>	<p>Geography</p> <p>We are going to find out about the different continents around the World.</p> <p>We started to learn about this last term so try to remember what you learnt then.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Learn about the continents and oceans</a></li> <li>• Label the seven continents on the map.
