The You Tube channel can be found via the parent information found here RWI parent information page</p> <p>Reading- RWI books</p> <p>Reread the story of the Elves and the Shoemaker.</p> <p>Read Mr and Mrs Cobbler's letter to the elves (on page 12).</p> <p>This week you could write a story to tell to Mr and Mrs Cobbler, where the elves help someone.</p> <p>There are many ideas on page 14 to help you to plan your story. You could draw a story map to record your ideas and help with your writing.</p> <p>Remember to reread your writing to check it.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The elves need to make an umbrella.</p> <p>Can you think of a fair test to see which material will be the best one for them to use? Remember that you need to test all of the materials in the same way.</p> <p>Once you have discovered which the best material is, you could write instructions for the elves so they can try the investigation too.</p> <p><i>This activity is on page 16 and 17 of the Elves and the Shoemaker booklet.</i></p>	<p>One Minute Challenge</p> <p>This week we would like you to do some <i>1 minute challenges</i>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How many times can you jump over an object? (Make sure it's not too high and that you are safe) - Can you balance on one leg for a minute? Maybe you could balance something on your head while you do it. - Make a floor target. Throw a ball or cuddly toy onto it. What is the best score you can achieve in 1 minute? - Create your own challenge.
