Once you have finished the story, work through the activities (up to page 12).</p> <p>You will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think about what you thought of the story • Use the description to draw and label a picture of Zeus. • Answer questions about the story. • Sort words into alphabetical order • Match words from the story to their definition (what they mean) and use them to write some sentences of your own. 	<p>History</p> <p>A few weeks ago, you found out about some of the jobs that animals do.</p> <p>This week, find out about a famous animal.</p> <p>Why is it famous? What did it do? When did it live? Did it help people or other animals?</p> <p>Here is an example.</p> <p>Cher Ami, was a messenger pigeon in the First World War. In 1918, 500 American troops were caught behind enemy lines and did not know how to reach safety. Two messenger pigeons were sent to tell the troops were to go but they failed to get there.
