Year 1 Wombats and Lemurs

P.E. – This year the children will have PE on Tuesday and Thursday.

Mathematics

We will be following the White Rose Maths Scheme for year 1. The focus for the spring term is addition and subtraction with place value to 50.

We will also be continuing to practise maths fluency every day, revising the Early Years and Year 1 curriculum focussed skills, including subitising.

English

The children will be using the Read Write Inc reading and spelling scheme. The focus is still building a more fluent reading style and knowledge of phonic skills.

There are more opportunities for independent writing to develop as their spelling develops.

Handwriting is focusing on pre cursive writing with an accurate and fluid style.

Wider Curriculum

For our Science lessons this term, we are looking at Animals including Humans and Plants. We are going to be learning about Mary Anning in History. In Geography, we are looking at the United Kingdom and the countries that are part of it. The technique in Art this term is weaving with textiles and we will be learning about notable artists such as Anni Albers, Megan Bogden-Shimek and Judit Just. We will also be exploring slider mechanisms in Design Technology. During our PE lessons we will be learning about Dance with Inspire+ and controlling movement in Gymnastics. Computing is focusing on using IT to write digitally and grouping data. In RE we are learning about Islam with a focus on the Qur'an and important festivals. In RSHE we will explore our dreams and goals as well as being healthy. More in depth planning can be found on the Academy website under Curriculum.
