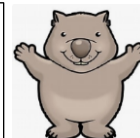




# Year 1 Curriculum Letter

## Autumn Term 2022



### Welcome to year 1 Wombats and Lemurs

**P.E.** – This year the children will have PE on **Mondays** and **Thursdays**. Please ensure that your child is wearing their coloured PE t-shirt and shorts. As the weather gets colder, they can wear plain, dark coloured leggings or joggers. All earrings must be removed or covered.

#### Mathematics

We will be following the White Rose Maths Scheme for year 1. The focus for the autumn term is place value, followed by addition and subtraction and then shape.

We will also be continuing to practise maths fluency every day, revising the Early Years curriculum focussed skills.

#### English

The children will be using the Read Write Inc reading and spelling scheme, as they did in Early Years. This will develop their fluency and comprehension with their reading, and develop their writing of grammatically correct sentences.

Pre-cursive handwriting is taught so that the children can develop the fluency and presentation of their writing.

#### Wider Curriculum

For our Science lessons this term, we are looking at Scientists and Inventors, learning about the wide variety of science disciplines. After half term, we will start investigating the weather and changes that occur during autumn and winter. We are going to be learning about Guy Fawkes and The Gunpowder Plot as a significant historical event. In Geography, we are learning about ways that the world is represented. The techniques in art this term are painting and drawing, and we will be looking at and evaluating the work of notable artists and working around the theme of animals. We will be looking at structures in Design Technology. For PE this term we learning the fundamental skills associated with sport and how to work as part of a team. Our music lessons follow the Charanga scheme and we will be learning how music can bring us together as friends. Computing is focusing on technology around us and digital painting. In RE we are learning about Christianity and its teachings. More in depth planning can be found on the Academy website under curriculum.
