Mathematics

We will be following the White Rose Maths in Y5.

We are focusing on:

- Statistics
- Shape – focusing upon angles
- Translation/reflection/symmetry
- Counting through/comparing negative numbers
- Converting units of measurement

You can help by:

- Practising multiplication facts and related division facts – using TTRS daily for 3mins
- Continuing to recall understanding of mathematical language.

English

In English, we are using the texts “Kacper” and “Who let the Gods out”

We are focusing on:

- Developing understanding of vocabulary and using it effectively.
- Extending our writing through non-chronological report; character description and diary entries.
- Using descriptive language and conjunctions to develop our ideas.

You can help by:

- Reading their books at least three times a week
- Practising spelling words from their reading books
- Reading and spelling the Year 5/6 words in the front and the back of their reading record.

Homework is given out on **Mondays**. Please encourage your child to read to you three times a week and play on TTRS as frequently as possible.
