Mathematics

We will be continuing to use the Numberblocks to support Mathematics in the Early Years.

We are focusing on:

- Counting beyond 10.
- Understanding numbers 8, 9 and 10 (and associated 2d shapes)
- One more/adding one
- One less/subtracting one
- Partitioning 6 into equal groups.
- Doubles

You can help by:

- Practising counting beyond 10 and back using number songs to help.
- Practising recognising numbers to 10 out and about e.g numbers on doors and buses.
- Using everyday items to add or subtract one e.g food on a plate, toys.

English

Children will continue to be using Read Write Inc.

We will continue to focus on:

- Learning more set 1 sounds including special friends (two letters that make one sound)
- Blending three or four sounds to read CVC words.
- Learning how to form each letter correctly.
- Fred Fingers for spelling.
- Holding/remembering a sentence.

You can help by:

- Follow the weekly Read Write Inc links and watch the videos with your child.
- Listen to your child read their book at least three times a week.
- Use the RWI handwriting phrase while practising letter formation at home. These can be found in the small green Phonics book.
