



EYFS Curriculum Letter Autumn Term 1 2025



Mathematics

We will continue to use the NCETM Numberblocks support materials.

We are focusing on:

- Counting forwards and backwards.
- Developing a sound knowledge of numbers 1 to 5 by looking at the relationships between those numbers and the patterns within them.
- Using a variety of manipulatives such as counters, cubes and pebbles.
- Recognising and naming basic 2d shapes.
- Comparing objects by height and/or capacity.

You can help by:

- Practising counting to 10 and back using number songs to help.
- Counting sets of real-life objects around the home.
- Looking out for examples of squares, circles, triangles and rectangles.

English

Children will be following the Read Write Inc (RWI) programme for their daily phonics sessions.

We are focusing on:

- Phonological awareness activities.
- Practising the RWI picture clues.
- Learning RWI set 1 sounds.
- Fred Talk to verbally blend sounds.
- Playing lots of Fred Talk games.
- Blending three sounds to read CVC words.
- Learning how to form each letter correctly.

You can help by:

- Attend the Phonics workshop for parents (details to be sent out soon).
- Follow the weekly Read Write Inc links and watch the videos with your child.
- Read their books at home with them at least three times a week (picture books to begin with)

Wider Curriculum/Topic

- **Communication and Language-** Discuss family photographs and re-telling of the Goldilocks and the Three Bears story.
- **Personal Social and Emotional Development-** Daily school routines and Jigsaw: 'Being me in my world.'
- **Physical Development-** Get Set 4 P.E Games Unit 1, Introduction to P.E. Various fine motor activities e.g manipulating dough, dot pictures, lacing cards.
- **Expressive Art & Design-** Inspirational artists Eric Carle and Franz Marc. Children to paint an animal of their own colour choice using colour mixing skills.
- **Understanding the World-** Making porridge (heating and cooling), Welly Walks around our school site.
- **Worldviews** – Myself: I am Special. Where do we belong? (family and school)
