Mathematics

We will be continuing the White Rose programme in Maths in Y2.

We are focusing on:

- Multiplication and division
- Addition and subtraction
- Starting to look at fractions and money

You can help by:

- Practising counting on and back in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- Continuing to practise number bonds to 10, 20, 100 and doubles of numbers.
- Using Money at home, counting different totals using different coins. Talking about change from 10p, 20p, 50p and £1

English

Children will continue to be using RWI and the Literacy Tree Curriculum in Y2.

We will continue to focus on:

- Reading words automatically
- Answering questions about what they have read with more accuracy and understanding
- Spelling common exception words correctly and other words phonetically
- Writing sentences with more accuracy and neater presentation using a pre-cursive/ cursive style

You can help by:

- Reading their books at least three times a week with a focus on vocabulary and questioning
- Reading and spelling the CEW words in the front and the back of their reading record
- Practise writing sentences using **because**, **but** and **so**.
