Mathematics

We are focusing on:

- multiplication and division, moving on to multiply and divide with 4 and 8.
- Multiplying and divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number with remainders.
- using inverse operations (+/- and x/÷) to check calculations
- estimating, sharing and grouping

You can help by:

- practising times tables using Times Tables Rock Stars for a minimum of 15 minutes per week.
- supporting your child with homework, when set. Homework will be set on Fridays, and is due in the following Tuesday.

English

We are focusing on:

- developing our writing by focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar
- writing character and setting descriptions, diary entries and recounts
- exploring vocabulary and techniques used by authors in a range of books
- reading aloud to develop fluency and retrieval skills

You can help by:

- reading 3 or more times per week with your child and signing the reading record. This is a homework expectation. Please check your child understands what they are reading.
- practising the Y3 & 4 spelling words. We suggest practising 5 spellings a week.

P.E - please wear **Academy PE kit** for the day and have earrings removed or covered with plasters.
Year 3 have PE on: **TUESDAYS and FRIDAYS**

- **Geography:** landscapes- looking at natural and man-made features
- **History:** Roman Empire- the occupation of Britain and the impact it had
- **Science:** rocks, fossils, soils and light
