



EYFS Curriculum Letter Summer Term 1 2026



Mathematics

We will continue to use the Numberblocks to support Mathematics in the Early Years.

We are focusing on:

- Number bonds up to 10
- Counting back from 10/20
- Finding one less/ subtracting one
- Adding more than one to make numbers 5-10.
- Comparison of numbers using greater than, less than and equal to.
- Finding the difference

You can help by:

- Practise counting back from 10/20 using number songs to help.
- Practise finding number bonds up to 10 (pairs of numbers that have totals 5-10)
- Using everyday items to compare amounts e.g who has the greater number of strawberries? Is 4 greater than, less than or equal to 6?

English

Children will continue to be using Read Write Inc.

We will continue to focus on:

- Consolidating Set 1 special friends (two letters that make one sound)- **sh, ch, th, qu, ng, nk.**
- Some groups will be learning Set 2 sounds- **ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy.**
- Blending three or four sounds to read words.
- Keep practising how to form each letter correctly.
- Fred Fingers for spelling.
- Writing a simple sentence.

You can help by:

- Follow the weekly Read Write Inc links and watch the videos with your child.
- Listen to your child read their book at least three times a week.
- Use the RWI handwriting phrase while practising letter formation at home. These can be found in the small green Phonics book.
