### Mathematics

We will be continuing to follow the White Rose programme in Maths in Y1.

**We are focusing on:**

- Multiplication and division – counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Fractions
- Position and direction
- Place value within 100
- Money
- Time

**You can help by:**

- Continuing to practise counting on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Looking at clocks regularly and discussing o'clock and half past.
- Discussing halves and quarters
- Looking at coins and notes and learning their value.
- Playing games involving directions.

### English

Children will continue to be using RWI and the Literary Curriculum.

**We will continue to focus on:**

- Increasing the fluency of reading with words read per minute
- Answering questions about what they have read with more accuracy and understanding
- Spelling Y1 common exception words (CEW) correctly and other words phonetically
- Continuing to understand the use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops when writing sentences.

**You can help by:**

- Reading the RWI home reader with your child regularly.
- Reading stories with your child.
- Practise spelling words using Fred fingers
- Writing sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
