Mathematics

We will be continuing to follow White Rose in Y4.

We are focusing on:

- place value
- addition and subtraction with three and four digit numbers
- multiplication and division with 12×12

You can help by:

- practising times tables using Times Tables Rock Stars
- supporting your child with homework, when set. Homework will be set on Fridays, and is due in the following Wednesday.

English

We will use a range of books to explore settings, character and plot this term.

We are focusing on:

- Year 4 RWInc spellings. Look out for spelling homework!
- writing character and setting descriptions, diary entries and recounts
- reading aloud to develop fluency and retrieval skills

You can help by:

- reading regularly with your child and signing the reading record **three times** a week
- practising the Y3 & 4 spelling words from their reading records
- checking your child understands what they are reading

P.E - please wear **Academy PE kit** for the day and have earrings removed or covered with plasters. Year 4 have PE on: **MONDAY and WEDNESDAY**

Wider Curriculum

Geography: Erosion and deposition and will compare how this differs in rivers and coasts.

History: Iron Age where we will be exploring their way of living and the impact the discovery of iron had on society.

Science: Biology, finding out about different types of animals and how these can be grouped. Chemistry, investigating solids, liquids and gases.

Art: mastering our drawing techniques, studying famous artists who have created a range of cityscapes and then creating our own.

Design Technology: designing and making paper products which use circuits to light a bulb.

PE: Dance and Netball

Computing: The internet and Internet safety.

World Views: How does Guru Nanak inspire Sikhs today? What does dharma teach about attitudes to the planet?

PSHE: 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating Difference'

Class Dojo and Parent Hub

We will be communicating via Class Dojo and you can message us too! Parent Hub is also an important source of communication, so please keep an eye out for any messages.

Homework: Homework will be given out weekly on Friday, and should be returned by Wednesday. This work will reinforce learning that has taken place in the classroom.
