Mathematics

We will be continuing to follow White Rose in Y3.

We are focusing on:

- place value
- addition and subtraction with two and three digit numbers
- multiplication and division, recapping the 2, 5 and 10 times tables before moving on to multiply and divide with 3, 4 and 8.

You can help by:

- practising times tables using Times Tables Rock Stars
- supporting your child with homework, when set. Homework will be set on Fridays, and is due in the following Tuesday.

English

We will use a range of books to explore settings, character and plot this term.

We are focusing on:

- Year 2 and 3 RWInc spellings
- writing character and setting descriptions, diary entries and recounts
- reading aloud to develop fluency and retrieval skills

You can help by:

- reading regularly with your child and signing the reading record
- practising the Y3 & 4 spelling words from their reading records
- checking your child understands what they are reading

Wider Curriculum

- **Geography:** features on maps, and Europe including populations, rivers and mountains.
- **History:** Stone Age exploring our ancestors and their way of life
- **Science:** our skeletons, movement, nutrition and diet, and rocks
- **Art:** abstract art, focusing on Yayoi Kusama
- **Design Technology:** linked levers and moving pictures
- **PE:** working on balance and ball skills
- **Computing:** connecting computers and online safety
- **World Views:** Islam and harmony and religious festivals
- **PSHE:** 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating Difference'

Class Dojo and Parent Hub

We will be communicating via Class Dojo and you can message us too! Parent Hub is also an important source of communication, so please keep an eye out for any messages.
