Please make sure you ask your child about any letters they may have been given. The best way to sort any problems with this would be to give us your email addresses.

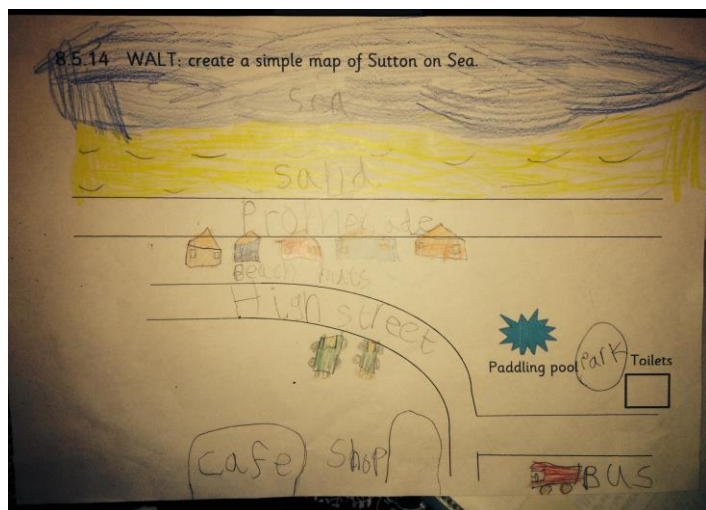
OUR TRIP TO SUTTON ON SEA by Connie H

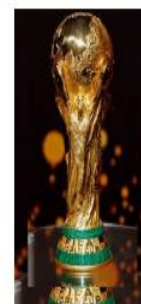
