7	Cannot generalise learning from one situation to another		
8	Makes mistakes in interpreting word problems		
9	Mixes up terms such as <i>equal to</i> , <i>larger than</i>		
10	Finds it difficult to remember basic maths facts		
11	Confuses maths symbols such as $+$, $-$, \times		
12	Has to recite the entire times table every time		
13	Loses track when counting		
14	Forgets the steps in a multi-step process		
15	Is confused about the difference between <i>12</i> and <i>21</i>		
16	Poor setting out of calculations and work on a page		
17	Gets confused with division: <i>is it 3 into 6 or 6 into 3?</i>		
18	Finds rounding numbers difficult
